- 4) Scattergrams on Naviance to determine the **competitiveness** of the schools
- 5) Research required college **admission requirements**
- 6) Attend the **in-state and out-of-state college fairs**. TBD: Sept/Oct 2023
- 7) **Visit colleges** in person or virtually. [Here](#) is a resource dedicated to virtual tour experience
- 8) **Visit College Reps** in Post Grad Center to ask questions and get to know more about the college and show demonstrated interest - Sign up located in Naviance
- 9) Brainstorming **essay topics**. Common App prompts [HERE](#)
- 10) SENIOR YEAR - **Attend College Application Presentation**: Sept 2023 - Previous year video available on [MoHi Counseling YouTube Channel](#)
- 11) You may need to **request letters of recommendation** - not all schools require them but start thinking about who you would want to write a letter and ask **at least a month in advance** and request in Naviance
- 12) **Transcript requests** can be made via the Transcript Request Form in the Post Grad Center
- 13) Colorado Application Free Days: usually 3rd week in October. Application fee is waived.
